13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

Burlington proposes to deepen this well. The current TD is 2930' and we would like to drill down to about 3115'. This well is just outside the Rosa PC pool and we do not anticipate any sustained gas flow from the PC, but we will use a mud logger to monitor the gas liberated drilling. This is located in the SW/4 of Section 11 of 30N, 6W. The additional footage will allow us to gain access to the remnant basal coal in the area and then to have a 90' sump below the coal for an improved operational configuration.
