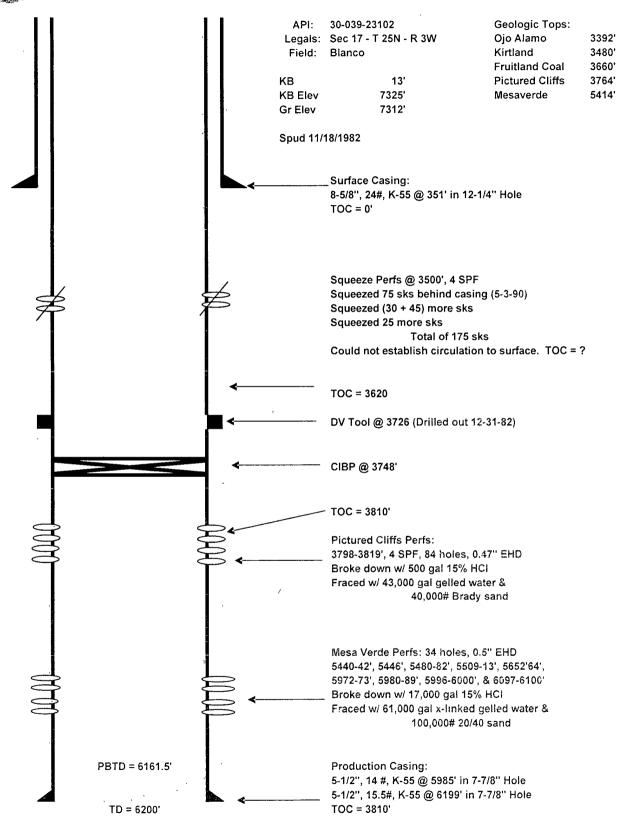

CW Roberts #7 Rio Arriba County, New Mexico Proposed P&A Schematic as of 1-15-2009

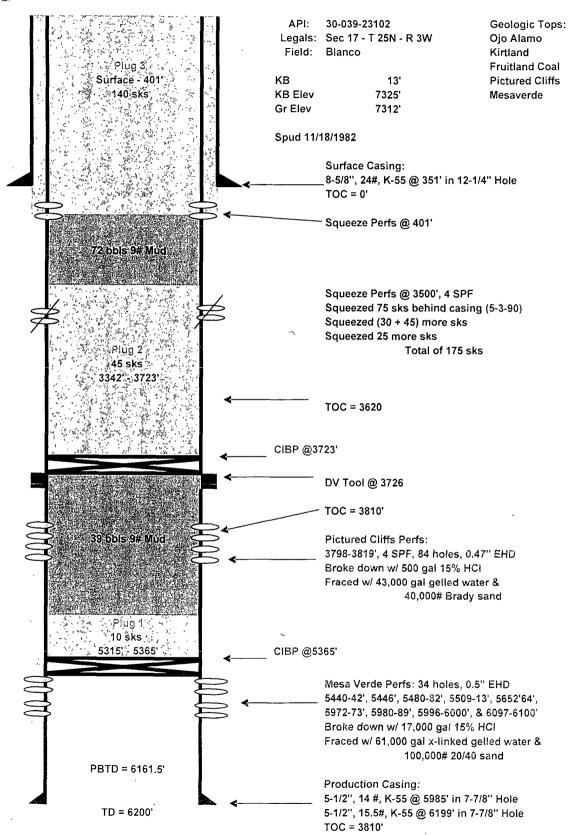
