## BACKGROUND:

This 1951 Vintage Barker Dome-Barker Creek well reportedly has cement circulated to surface behind the surface 13-3/8" at 297 with 250 sx cement circulated to surface, the 9 5/8" set at 2847" with 900 sx cement, the 7" at 9022 with 1750 sx cement. The work-over pit shall be reclaimed directly after the rig moves off location, contaminated soils removed and the fluids pumped off. This exception is granted for this event only and should not be considered a standard exemption for other wells with work-over pits. The reason for the need of extra time shall be documented on all future sundry notices to this effect.
