April 21, 2009 the BLM approved BP to either clean out wellbore & restore to production, T&A the DK or Plug the entire wellbore if casing integrity issues were found.

May 2009: Casing integrity issues were found & BP decided to perform casing repair in an attempt to restore to production. At that time the P&A procedure was cancelled.

After several attempts with a swab unit BP has determined that the well can not be restored to production.

BP respectfully requests the BLM reinstate the original P&A procedure that was approved April 21, 2009
