Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **A ConocoPhillips Company employee discovered a release of approximately 66 MCF of natural gas at the SJ 28-7 #229F on the morning of 7/23/08 due to a blown rupture disk. The rupture disk has previously blown on this location on 7/17/08 causing a 54 MCF release. The motor valve was adjusted and the trim and seat was replaced after the earlier release, but this did not correct the problem. Upon discovery, the employee shut in the well.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* **The natural gas was released to the atmosphere. The rupture disk was replaced, and the well was returned to service. A crew also replaced the Ametek controller to prevent reoccurrence.**
