

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

On October 2, 2008, the Well Site Leader for Rig 825 notified the Wells Field Superintendent of a flowback tank that was damaged during a rig move on the Gage Com 1M. Approximately 14 barrels of produced water spilled as a result of the incident. The flowback tank was being loaded on a rig-up truck and was halfway up on the tail roller when the tank skid collapsed on left side. Some of the produced water from the tank exited the top hatch when the vessel lay on its side. NMOCD was notified of the release and the spill area will be remediated. The tank was damaged as a result of the incident and a subsequent investigation is being lead by the trucking company.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Soil on location and a nearby natural drainage was impacted. The area will be allowed to dry and any salt stain will be removed.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment.
