Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **The rotating rubber failed while unloading the hole with air on the Allison Unit 2B, on the morning of 9/22/08. An Aztec Well Service employee observed approximately 30 BBL of displacement water (fresh water) unload through the rig floor through the derrick. Upon discovery, the hole was unloaded with air and the rotating rubber was replaced.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **The displacement water was clean water with no additives. To prevent reoccurrence, COPC had the rotating rubber replaced during drilling operations.**
