


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **On 12-09-08 during Frac Operations on location an operator discovered a valve that was left open and approximately 200 gal 2% KCl and approximately 45 gal gelling agent (GW-3LDF) was discharged to the ground. Upon discovery, the operation was shut down and the valve was closed.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* **The frac fluid was released to the ground & all remained on location. Dawn Trucking was called & recovered approximately 245 gal of standing fluid. COPC will monitor soil conditions to determine if further remediation is necessary. To prevent reoccurrence, contractor will be instructed to check valves before frac operations begin on location.**
