recovered and all water was contained in the berm. Dawn Trucking steam-cleaned the area within the bermed area										
and was able to recover the residue from the spill and disposed of approximately 80 BBL of water & ground-covering										
at IEI, Inc. landfarm. COPC will monitor the soils after the ground has thawed for environmental impact. To prevent										
reoccurrence, COPC will continue to monitor pit tank levels.
