


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **A Western Refining driver discovered a condensate spill of approximately 11 BBL at the San Juan 28-6 #255F on the afternoon of 4/10/08 due to a tank overflow. The kill switch on the tank was installed but malfunctioned. Upon discovery, the well was shut in.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* **All of the spilled fluids were contained within the berm, and approximately 10 BBL were recovered by water truck and returned to the production tank. The kill switch was repaired. To prevent reoccurrence, COP will monitor production levels.**
