valve on the production tank due to a freeze and an approximate 10 BBL condensate & 8.3 produced water was											
released in the berm. Upon discovery, the MSO shut in the well and notified a Supervisor. All spilled fluids remained in the berm. None of the fluids were recoverable.											
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* All of the spilled fluids remained on location. The spill impacted soil on the											
ground surface around the tank. The production tank was removed and affected soils were excavated. M&M											
Trucking excavated approximately 132 yd3 of hydrocarbon impacted soil. The soil was hauled to a commercial											
landfarm, IEI. Approximately 132 yd3 of clean backfill was brought back to the location for facility reset. Envirotech											
completed the conformation sampling to confirm that all impacted soil was recovered. To prevent reoccurrence, COPC will continue to perform tank inspections.
