Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Improperly closed ball valve on outlet of tank line froze and broke overnight, causing spillage outside of berm. The valve and line are to be removed from the tank such that future removals will require a hose to be directly hooked to the tank and removed when pumping is complete.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Tank liquids (consisting of oily water) were spilled to soil around the berm. The spill was completely absorbed into the soil, no standing liquid remains. The soil is to be removed by an appropriate contractor and taken to an appropriate landfarm for treatment by 10 January 2002.
