Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Contractor removed the firetube on 2/8/02 and when he reinstalled the manway he didn't tighten the bolts properly. This is the initial determination. The operator visited the location on 2/21/02, Thursday and manway wasn't leaking. When he found the leak today (Tuesday) there was approx. 20 bbls of produced water within the berm. Immediately he tightened the bolts and called the trucking company. Approx. 90% of the spill (18 bbls) was been recovered.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Spilled produced water did not leave location. NOTE: The berm still has ice from previous spill from the first part of this month that hasn't thawed.
