Source - leaking 3" valve and bull plug assembly from a 210 bbl produced water tank, which "un-threaded" as a unit when the Key driver was only trying to remove the bull plug to pull a load.

Spilled produced water did not leave location. The 9 bbls of water recovered was taken to the 29-6 #301 SWD for disposal. No further action will be taken to remediate.
