The well was shut-in at the time, therefore all water was from the produced water pipeline. The pipeline was isolated near the location. A pumper in the area was immediately dispatched to check all shut-in wells to see if the same problem could develop**

**The produced water soaked in on location. The impacted soil will be landfarmed on site. Repairs on the produced water pipeline will be completed in the spring, which will involve burying the above ground valve.**
