

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **A produced water spill of 10 BBL was discovered at the San Juan 27-4 Unit #47P on 8/7/07 by a Dawn Trucking water hauler, due to a 500 BBL produced water tank overflowing when the well could not be accessed because of muddy roads, weather, and poor communication by the water hauler. All fluids were contained on the location in the immediate area of the tank, with 8 BBL recovered by a vacuum truck.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **All fluids were contained on the location in the immediate area of the tank, with 8 BBL recovered by a vacuum truck. For remediation of the remaining impacted soils, an application of "gator soaker" was applied.**
