Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*



The compressor on the location caught fire. It is estimated that approximately 1800 MCF of natural gas was burned during the fire. It appears that the start gas line separated at the "dead man" valve and the gas was ignited by the engine.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

No liquids were released. Released gas was burned.

Investigation showed that the dead man valve may have not been seated properly on the pipe and that the bracing for the start gas line may have been loose.
