If a Watercourse was Impacted, Describe Fully.*

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **Between the evening of 7/3/07 and the morning of 7/9/07, someone with a high powered rifle shot holes in diesel storage tanks, a hydraulic tank, and antifreeze storage tanks at the Huerfano #500, spilling approximately 300 gallons of a mixture of these fluids to the ground, affecting an area 20' X 20', all contained on location. Aztec Well Service Rig #376 was on location, which sustained most of the damage. All the windows in the cab of the rig were shot out, the weight indicator was shot, three (3) tires were shot, radiator on pump was shot, and the freeze plugs were shot on the rig engine. The San Juan County Sheriffs Department investigated this incident, in addition to several other oilfield equipment shooting incidents in the area. The affected soils will be excavated and hauled offsite to a commercial landfarm after the rig moves off location.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **All spilled fluids remained on location and affected an area 20' x 20'. The affected soils will be excavated and hauled offsite to a commercial landfarm after the rig moves off location.**
