

A transfer pump failed causing the produced water tank to fill up and equalize/over flow to the next tank. A clamp on the equalizing line froze and started leaking. The tanks were emptied via a vacuum truck. The equalizing line was repaired the next day.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The ground was frozen allowing the ability to vacuum all produced water that was released to the ground. No remediation required.
