Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
During a well control incident, drilling fluids were diverted out the choke lines to the blowback berm. The drilling fluid travelled around the end of the berm and off location.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken *
The drilling fluid travelled around the end of the berm and followed natural topography off location approximately 300 yards in a path about one foot wide. The impacted soils were mixed w/ the native soils with the use of rakes and shovels.
