

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Several frack tanks were on location awaiting a job to start up. It was reported by a citizen that someone had shot the frack tank. Upon investigation it was determined that the frack tank had been shot and water was escaping the tank through the bullet holes. The frack tank contained uncontaminated fresh water. Approximately 10 bbls of fresh water was spilled onto the ground.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The water was transferred from the tank that had been shot to an existing empty tank. The spill was contained to the well site and the area will be allowed to dry.
