Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* A hole in the fire tube on a skim tank resulted in a spill of 125 BBL of produced water and 45 BBL of oil, which was discovered on Monday morning, 4/18/05, by the lease operator. The spilled fluids remained inside the secondary containment dike, and vacuum trucks recovered 45 BBL of oil and 30 BBL of produced water from the diked area. An estimated 95 BBL of produced water is presumed to have soaked down into the soil inside the unlined diked area. Operations at the disposal are shut in and repairs are being made to the fire tube to prevent further spills.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* An estimated 95 BBL of produced water is presumed to have soaked down into the soil inside the unlined diked area. Operations at the disposal are shut in and repairs are being made to the fire tube to prevent further spills. Because this SWD facility is being redesigned by our engineers for changes to be made in the near future, we would like to delay remediation activities until this planned construction time when the tanks can be removed and proper excavation of soils can be done. At that time, the spill area will be excavated and all stained soil will be taken to a commercial landfarm off-site.
