Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken *

A small pin hole leak in the base of storage tank along a weld contact seam. The tank was removed and replaced with a new tank.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

An area 3X3 feet soil stain adjacent to tank leak. The soil was excavated from an area 42 feet x 26 feet x 8 feet deep (approximately 242 cu yds). The impacted soil was landfarmed on the incident location and the adjacent Hurefano #189. The excavation stopped at sandstone that was discovered at 6 - 8 feet in depth. A minor area at bottom of excavation 6 feet x 6 feet had visible staining on sandstone. The remaining lateral extent of impacted soil overburden was removed above the sandstone. Clean fill soil was backfilled into excavation and the location was
