

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Contractor working for producer accidentally ran into dog leg during routine operation of the well site causing a 2" fitting to crack. Contractor immediately notified Enterprise. The well was shut in and the line blown down by 6:50 p.m. on 4/28/2005. Repairs were made and the line was placed back in service at 10:30 a.m. on 4/29/2005.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Gas was released to atmosphere, no damage to surface.
