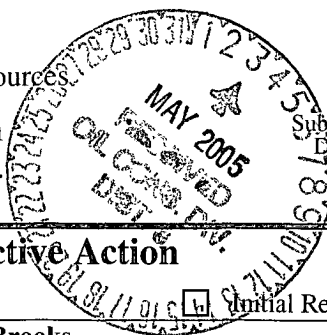

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Triple S called in leaking condensate on the Bolack B 8. A BP tech was dispatched and discovered a leaking dump line going to the condensate tank. The well was shut in, and a work order will be entered to repair the leak. 6 barrels of condensate released, none recovered.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

After a one call was submitted, and excavation started, it was determined that the soil had no staining and no evidence of hydrocarbon saturation or smell present. This well has a total ranking score of 0 on ground water, surface water and wellhead protection, so the soil was mixed with the fresh dirt we had in place, and refilled the excavation and spread the rest on location.
