While Dawn Trucking was hauling one of their tanks to IEI for cleaning, some oil sloshed out of the 400 bbl tank onto the road at several places. Largest area was at the corner of Crouch Mesa Road and CR 3100. The tank had been emptied down to the drain valve but some residual oil had remained.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

The county fire department had responded and had put sand on the oil on the road. IEI completed the cleanup by removing the impacted sand / gravel and disposing at the commercial disposal facility.
