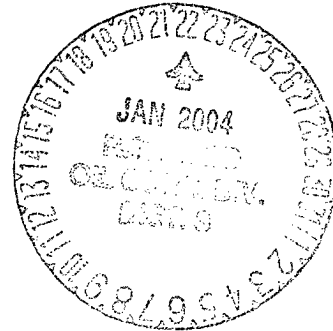

Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the No. 285 San Juan 28-7 Unit well, located 935' FSL and 905' FEL, Section 26, T28N, R7W, Rio Arriba, New Mexico. This APD was approved on April 25, 2001 with an expiration date of October 25, 2002. This APD was approved for a year and a half.
