

JUSTIFICATION OF ALLOCATION: The allocation for the Aztec Federal is being revised due to the Dakota formation being plugged. These percentages are based upon the original isolated flow tests from the Mesaverde and Chacra formations during completion operations. Oil was not present during flow test operations. For that reason, oil percentages are based upon the gas allocation and are provided in the event this wellbore begins producing oil at some point in the future.

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
