Details of Plan of Work: SHOW SIZES, WEIGHTS AND DEPTHS OF PROPOSED CASINGS; ALSO MUDDING JOBS, CEMENTING JOINTS AND ALL OTHER IMPORTANT PROPOSED WORK.

Well was drilled to 1836 on June 21, 1927. The objective sand from 1646 to 1676 carried water. It was decided to use well for water supply and for which purpose it has subsequently been used.

The 12 1/2" conductor, set at 53', and the 10" string, set at 1010' have been pulled. The 8 1/2" string was cemented at 1459'.
