XTO Energy has CBL's that were ran 4/13/01 and 5/18/01 by Texacoma Oil & Gas Corp. The CBL ran 4/13/01 shows a TOC at 600'. They pumped 65 sacks cement down the bradenhead on 4/15/01. The CBL ran 5/18/01 shows a bond from surface to 200' covering the casing shoe at 182'. On 4/8/01 the surface casing was tested to 1000 psig for 15 minutes. XTO Energy has no records of the production casing being tested.
