Hicks Oil & Gas, Inc. (based on increasing water production) suspects the above mentioned well has developed a casing leak. Plans are to set a RBP at ~5200' (top perf at 5270'). Then pressure test casing/RBP. If pressure test fails will then isolate hole(s) with casing packer. After the leak is identified (depth and pump in pressure) a cement squeeze job will be designed to eliminate leak. Plan to use Type III cement (will add 2% CaCl₂ if leak is above 2000'). If possible will try to circulate cement out braden head. Initial temp survey suggest top of cement at 2,040'.
