The 1st Stage was pumped with no circulation losses and returns of pre-flush to the surface, but no cement. **BLM (Troy Salyers) and OCD (Kelly Roberts) were contacted on 9/7/10 and permission was received to continue pumping the 2nd Stage cement, WOC and run a CBL on 9/8. The 2nd Stage was completed with returns of cement to surface. The CBL was performed on 9/8/10 and BLM (Troy Salyers) and OCD (Kelly Roberts) were contacted and verbal approval was received to move forward without remediation. The CBL is attached.**
