Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) for the following well(s):

Valencia Canyon Unit #47A well, located **820' FSL and 1940' FEL, Section 22, T28N, R4W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico**. This APD was approved on June 3, 2008 with an expiration date of June 3, 2010. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location. 30-039-30499

Storey B #7R well, located **1890' FSL and 1975' FWL, Section 5, T30N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico**. This APD was extended on February 27, 2008 with an expiration date of March 30, 2010. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location. 30-045-33045
