Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) for the following wells:

Shiotani Federal #500S well, located 1085' FSL and 1600' FEL, Section 8, T29N, R12W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This APD was extended on May 16, 2008 with an expiration date of August 11, 2009. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location.

San Juan 30-6 Unit #416S well, located 1595' FNL and 905' FWL, Section 24, T30N, R7W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This APD was approved on September 19, 2005 with an expiration date of September 19, 2007. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location.

San Juan 29-7 Unit #565S well, located 2500' FNL and 2600' FWL, Section 26, T29N, R7W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. This APD was approved on October 19, 2005 with an expiration date of October 19, 2007. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location.

In view of the foregoing, this office is rescinding the approval due to the expiration of the APDs. In addition, we will require a letter confirming that no surface disturbing activities have been conducted at the well sites. Please file letter within 30 days of receipt of this notice. Any surface disturbance conducted must be rehabilitated in accordance with the standards and guidelines established by this office.
