Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) for the following wells:

**Shiotani Federal #500S** well, located **1085' FSL and 1600' FEL, Section 8, T29N, R12W, San Juan County, New Mexico**. This APD was extended on May 16, 2008 with an expiration date of August 11, 2009. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location. 30-045-33231

**San Juan 30-6 Unit #416S** well, located **1595' FNL and 905' FWL, Section 24, T30N, R7W, San Juan County, New Mexico**.
