11/10-11/11/10: NU BOP. Pressure test casing to 600#/30 minutes. OK. Test Choke Manifold & pipe rams 250 psi low/5 min, 3000 high/10 min. Test bline rams & kelly valve 5 min - 250 low to 10 min -3000 high.
