Reference is made to the following:

(a) your application (**administrative application reference No. pTGW10-29948979**) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on October 26, 2010, and

(b) the Division's records pertinent to this request.

D.J. Simmons, Inc. [OGRID 5587] (Simmons) has requested to drill the above-referenced well at an unorthodox gas well location described above in the caption of this letter. The SW/4 equivalent of irregular Section 7 will be dedicated to this well in order to form a non-standard, 124-acre, more or less, gas spacing unit in the Otero-Chacra Gas Pool (82329). This pool is governed by statewide Rule 15.10.C, which provides for 160-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 660 feet from the northern and eastern unit boundaries.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 and 4.12.A(2).

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location in order to utilize an existing wellbore.

This approval is subject to your being in compliance with all other applicable Division rules, including, but not limited to Division Rule 5.9.

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
