Carson Unit #24, Unit Letter N, Section 18, Township 25 North, Range 11 West, API 30-045-05343

Dear Mr. Linderman:

On February 17, 2004, New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) Deputy Inspector Bruce Martin found that the referenced well was in violation of OCD order WFX-592.

An OCD inspection and investigation determined the following:

- 1. The injection pressure at the Carson Unit #24 was 1100 PSIG, which exceeded the maximum injection surface pressure of 972 PSIG authorized by OCD order WFX-592.
- 2. The pressure-limiting device setting was above 1200 PSIG, which exceeded the maximum injection surface pressure setting required by OCD order WFX-592.

At a meeting with Elm Ridge personnel at the well site, Elm Ridge was instructed to bring the well into compliance immediately. Further violation will result in enforcement action that could include public hearing, cancellation of authority to inject, or civil penalties.
