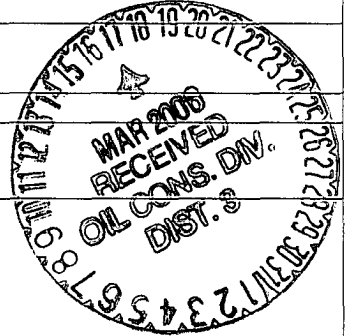

Operations Tech new to area unknowingly left open 1" fuel line after calibration. Because the line was frozen the Op-Tech was unaware of the fact that he had left the line open, he then left the area and was absent from work for 10 days due to the holidays. Upon next visit to the location Op-Tech exited vehicle and could hear the gas release. After a 20 minute investigation the 1" fuel line was discovered and locked in to prevent further reoccurrences.

1" Abandoned Fuel Line locked in to preventive reoccurrences.
