Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **A produced water spill of approximately 75 BBL was discovered on 11/22/05 near the San Juan 32-7 Unit #246, due to a produced water pipeline leak. The pipeline was then shut in immediately. The spill affected soils along the pipeline in an area 525' long x 1' wide x 1" deep (calculating to less than 1/2 BBL spilled). There was also water standing in a culvert (valve can), of which 60 BBL was recovered by vacuum truck. The amount remaining in the culvert that could not be recovered by vacuum truck was approximately 100' x 10' x 1" deep (calculating to 15 BBL unrecoverable). A one-call has been made and the pipeline remains shut in until repairs are made.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **The spill affected soils along the pipeline in an area 525' long x 1' wide x 1" deep (calculating to less than 1/2 BBL spilled). There was also water standing in a culvert (valve can), of which 60 BBL was recovered by vacuum truck. A one-call has been made and work will begin on excavating in the area of the pipeline leak to determine the cause and repair the line and also to excavate affected soils, if necessary. If the investigation shows remediation is required, stained soils will be excavated and hauled to Envirotech and the excavated area will be backfilled with clean fill dirt.**
