Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **A condensate spill of 35 BBL was discovered on Monday morning, 12/20/04. The butterfly drain valve on the condensate tank froze and split, resulting in the spill which affected an area of 14' 5" x 17' x 18" deep, all contained within the berm. The well was shut in until a non-freeze valve can be installed.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **The spill affected an area of 14' 5" x 17' x 18" deep within the berm. Remediation activities will start on Thursday, 12/23/04 after the one-call is in effect. All stained soil will be excavated and taken to the Envirotech landfarm. This will be the final report.**
