Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

A produced water spill of 22 BBL occurred 12/29/04. The spill was contained within the bermed area. The electric motor burned out on water pump. Operator Jim Bowman contacted Key Energy and requested water truck to pull water from tank. Upon arrival on location the driver of the water truck discovered the spill. It is estimated 20 BBL were recovered with a vacuum truck and hauled to Key Energy disposal facility.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

No water left the bermed area. Vacuum truck recovered approximately 20 BBL of produced water from berm and hauled to Key Energy Disposal. This will be the final report.
