Water was contained within the barrow of the road. Denny Foust of OCD suggested that we scrape up what soil we know was impacted, put it on location and spread it out. Steve Austin of the Navajo EPA instructed us to collect a sample of the impacted soil, have it tested, and if it falls below the maximum allowed in the Navajo Nation remediation guidelines, we may spread the impacted soil on the well pad.											
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*  Wells in the field were shut in until ruptured line could be repaired. Water truck was dispatched to suck up free-standing water and road has been bladed. Due to the wet conditions of this morning, it is infeasible to scrape up and land farm moist soil, as ALL of the soil is moist due the current precipitation. A sample of the impacted soil was collected and taken to iina ba for testing. We are awaiting results of said test, and report same as soon as we get them.
