Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* One of the tanks at the disposal site overflowed causing approximately 18 barrels of produced water and 2 barrels of lube oil to be released to the berm. All 18 barrels of the water and 1.5 barrels of lube oil was recovered.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The spill was completely contained with the gravel dike. The free liquids were recovered.
