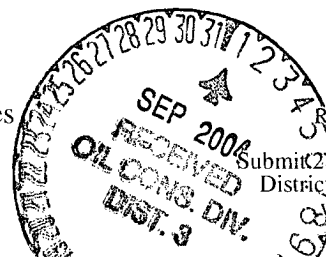

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

During the frac of our well, fluid began flowing out of the bradenhead. During the frac, the casing failed allowing fluid to migrate to surface. 10 barrels of produced water was released on to location into a bermed area. The frac job was shut down, and a water truck on location recovered 6 barrels of the water. The well has been successfully cemented. This release was originally communicated as 40 barrels, however Triple S truck driver informed us that his truck was on a hill when he read his gauge, and once the truck was level, corrected his figures.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

The 4 barrels that was not recovered soaked in the ground on location.
