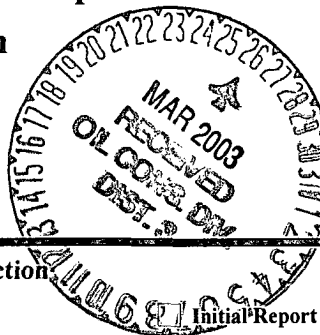

No liquids were released. The fire was contained in and around the pit tank and separator.
