Dear Miss Dysart:

This is to notify you that drilling on your proposed location (southwest quarter southwest quarter southwest quarter section 11, Township 11 North, Range 9 West) may not commence until such time as you have verified the fact that your intended location is actually on fee lands. Your drill site appears within the boundaries of Cibola National Forest, McKinley County, New Mexico.

This land has been reconveyed to the Federal Government, a fact which was today verified by Mr. Joseph C. Conrace, Manager, District Land and Survey Office of the Bureau of Land Management.

As you know, any drilling operations on Federal Lands comes under the supervision of the United States Geological Survey for whom you must furnish bond and conduct your operations under their supervision.

Copies of this directive are being mailed to Mr. Foster Morrell, Supervisor, Mr. Jack Frost, and Oil and Gas Inspector for the Commission, Mr. Al Greer, who should be cognizant of the situation.
