A letter dated December 10, 1956, from this office, requested forms C-103 (Miscellaneous Reports on Wells), and Form C-105 (Well Record), on your #1 Woodward well, located in SE/4 Sec 19-16N-5W.

We do not have the reports at this time.

Our rules require forms C-103 to be filed within 10 days after each operation is completed. They also require form C-105 to be filed within 20 days of completion of any well.

Rule #202 is as follows: a(c) "When drilling operations have been suspended for 60 days, the well shall be plugged and abandoned unless a permit for temporary abandonment shall be obtained from the Commission".

It is recommended that immediate action be taken by your company to comply with these regulations.

We do not have the reports at this time.

Our rules require forms C-103 to be filed within 10 days after each operation is completed. They also require Form C-102 to be filed within 30 days of completion of any well.

Rule #102 is as follows: (c) "When drilling operations have been suspended for 30 days, the well shall be plugged and abandoned unless a permit for temporary abandonment shall be obtained from the Commission".

It is recommended that immediate action be taken by your company to comply with these regulations.
