1. Drill 12-1/4" hole to approximately 80'. Set 8-5/8", 20#/ft. surf. csq. at approximately 80' and cement to surface.
2. Drill 7-7/8" hole to total depth of approximately 3900' to test the "D" sand of the Dakota formation, expected to be encountered at approximately 3770'. Run IES and Density logs. Run DST, if necessary.
3. Should commercial production be found, 4-1/2" casing will be run and cemented across prospective productive zones.
4. 4-1/2" csq. will be perforated for completion and formation treated for stimulation.
5. Test well for production and complete.

IN ABOVE SPACE DESCRIBE PROPOSED PROGRAM: If proposal is to deepen or plug back, give data on present productive zone and proposed new productive zone. 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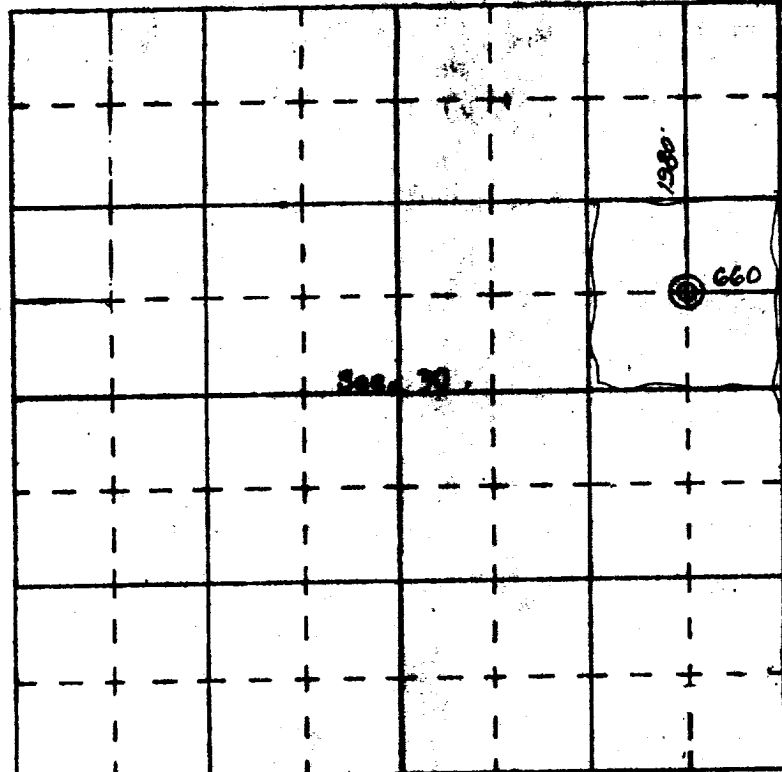
