

Dear Mr. Stover:

A recent inspection of your No. 1 Paperthin well, located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 26, T. 19 N., R. 5 W., McKinley County, New Mexico, on Federal lease NM-7772, disclosed that live oil had drained out of two tanks at the site of the plugged well.

You are hereby allowed 10 days to clean up this polluted area and removed the trash. We have requested restoration stipulations from the Bureau of Land Management and they will be furnished to you at a later date. It is suggested that the tanks be removed to permit reseeding of the area. Approval of the abandonment and termination of the period of bonded liability is pending restoration of the wellsite.
